# In Town Levees

## WP-42A.1/A.3 (4th St N Pump Station) – February 2016

- 💧 Conducted pipe testing of 36" storm water piping
- 💧 Installed platform and ladders in gatewell
- 💧 Placed concrete for box culvert lids

## WP-42A.2 (2<sup>nd</sup> Street Pump Station) – February 2016

- 💧 Installed five storm water pumps
- 💧 Installed brick veneer
- 💧 Installed conduit, lighting, and sensors
- 💧 Excavated for bridge abutment
- 💧 Installed piling for bridge abutment





# WP-42C.2 (Park East Demolition) – February 2016

- Completed asbestos abatement
- Finished apartment building demolition
- Continued demolition and clean-up of garages
