

Major Activities in Past Month

- Governors Burgum and Dayton have begun discussions on a permanent flood control solution.
- Oxbow levee construction continues in accordance with the stipulated agreement that allows construction through 2017, and with concurrence from MNDNR.
- New Intown levee construction is on hold.
- CR 16 & 17 realignment is on hold.
- P3 procurement activities are on hold.
- Land acquisitions are on hold.

Upcoming Priorities

- Support discussions with the MNDNR and other parties to resolve the current legal dispute and advance a FM flood control solution.
- Continue OHB home removals and construction as previously authorized.
- Obtain court's approval to install a temporary roadway for the CR16
 & 17 intersection that eliminates the current 6-mile detour.
- Retain the three P3 proposers while discussions continue.
- Prepare for MG Kaiser's visit on October 11.
- Support increased communications between FMDA and upstream parties.
- Right-size the PMC staff and level of effort to accommodate the court order.




