In Town Levees WP-42A.1/A.3 (4th St N Pump Station) – July 2016


- Continuing to address box culvert concerns before pump testing can proceed
- Completed mulching along sidewalk and floodwall, and warming house electrical work





In Town Levees WP-42A.2 (2nd Street Pump Station) – July 2016


- Conducting testing/start-up of pump station
- Pump station
 Substantial
 Completion expected
 mid July
- Remaining work to be completed Fall 2016 (screen wall, bollards, fence)





In Town Levees WP-42F.1S (2nd St Flood Control, South) – July 2016


- Began concrete paving of 2nd St North
- Installed removable floodwall footings
- Began removal and disposal of contaminated soils in former Case Plaza lot





In Town Levees WP-42F.1N (2nd St Flood Control, North) – July 2016

- Installed 12 floodwall sections and footings for 5 additional sections
- Coordinated transfer of HoJo site from C.1 contractor to F.1N contractor

 Fargo Public Schools renovation complete, working contract close-out




