

### In Town Levees WP-42A.1/A.3 (4th St N Pump Station) – March 2016

- Pump station structure and electrical complete; preparing for pump tests
- Addressing construction concerns with box culvert slope





#### In Town Levees WP-42A.2 (2<sup>nd</sup> Street Pump Station) – February 2016

- Contractor completed Milestone 1A (pump station structure, finishes, electrical, and pump install)
- Work activity to drop off until permanent power install (under different contract) this summer





# WP-42C.1 (Howard Johnsons Demolition) WP-42C.2 (Park East Demolition)

#### WP-42C.1 (Howard Johnsons Demolition)

- Mobilized to site, installed fencing
- Beginning preparations for abatement work

#### WP-42C.2 (Park East Demolition)

- Completed demolition and clean-up of the building with exception of one basement
- Basement contains previously unknown asbestos, will require new Change Order to address



# WP-42H.2 (El Zagal Phase 2) – March 2016
