Kris Bakkegard became the first Metro Flood Diversion Authority director of engineering in July 2020.

Previously, he worked for 25 years with KLJ as a civil engineer, division leader, and engineering group manager. His experience with KLJ spanned design and project management for bridges, urban and rural roadways, and flood control projects as well as involvement with surveying, environmental work, right-of-way work, and construction.
