A regular meeting of the Metro Flood Diversion Authority Finance committee was held on March 23, 2022. The following members were present: Bernie Dardis, Mayor, City of West Fargo; Dr. Tim Mahoney, Mayor, City of Fargo; Chad Peterson, Cass County Commissioner; Dan Jacobson, Chairman, Cass County Joint Water Resource District; Kent Costin, City of Fargo Finance Director; Lori Johnson, Clay County Auditor/Treasurer; Mike Redlinger, City of Fargo Assistant Administrator; Rick Steen, Cass County Commissioner and Brandy Madrigga, Cass County Finance Director.

Members absent: Dave Piepkorn, Fargo City Commissioner; Shelly Carlson, Mayor, City of Moorhead and Mike Rietz, City of Moorhead Assistant City Manager.

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Dardis called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. Roll call was taken, and a quorum was present.

## 2. APPROVE MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 2022 MEETING

## 4. APPROVAL OF BILLS

## FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Costin reported that \$788,140,988 is the grand total spent to date and our net position is \$102,869,898.



Mr. Costin also reported that funds are available to be drawn from the Bank of North Dakota upon submission of a summary of expenses. Mr. Costin made a recommendation that funds be drawn from the Bank of North Dakota as well as the legislative funds to avoid any criticism of the funds not being accessed equally.

## **MOTION PASSED**

Dr. Mahoney moved to approve the financial report as presented and Mr. Costin's recommendation to draw equally from the Bank of North Dakota and legislative funds and Mr. Steen seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried.

## 6. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Paulsen provided a report of the annual revenue status, budget report out and budget summary. The majority of expenses continue to be in engineering, legal and administrative. To date, \$780 million has been spent and we continue to track on budget.

The Metro Flood Diversion Authority ("Owner") and JT Lawn Services & Landscaping, Inc. ("Contractor) is to enter into a Services Agreement to provide mowing and weed control services to the Metro Flood Diversion Authority. The Owner and Consultant agree as follows:

Provide mowing and weed control management for the following areas:

- Prairie grass mowing and weed control for the OHB Levee and OINs 2354, 8923 and ditch ND).
- Residential management of OINs 1128, 1955, 9403, 9411, 9576-9579 all North Dakota parcels.
- Rural residential management of OIN 837 North Dakota and OIN 1834, 9160/9170 and 9234 Minnesota.
- Spring and fall weed management of OIN 5033 and 7004 both North Dakota.

#### **REASON:**

The primary purpose of mowing is to improve its appearance. Proper mowing technique, equipment, frequency and height of cut will improve the quality of a grassed area while also increasing the health of the grass plants and decreasing weeds. The removal of weeds is useful because these unwanted plants compete with the crop for space, water and nutrients.

To address noxious weeds that grow within the native vegetation (the main weed we've seen is Canada thistle, but there may be other noxious weeds. Ditch Mowing along Hwy 81 and adjacent to OINs 2354 & 8923, as required by State and Local laws, including the weed control of noxious weeds.

# Rural Impact Mitigation Program (RIMP) Executive Summary

APRIL 19, 2022

The following executive summary provides an overview of the current status of the Rural Impact Mitigation Program (RIMP), the previous actions by the Metro Flood Diversion Authority Board (Board) and necessary actions by the Board to continue use of the RIMP.

#### **OVERVIEW**

The need for the RIMP was identified in late 2019. Relocation benefits required by the Uniform Relocation Act (the "URA") (and its state-level equivalents) are different for residential properties and business properties. Residential properties are eligible under the URA for the costs to acquire a substitute property, up to a certain amount. There is no similar URA benefit for commercial properties. The differences between treatment of residential and commercial properties under the URA created challenges in negotiating with the owners of active farmsteads and rural businesses. Since these active farmsteads and rural businesses were each unique, the RIMP was developed. The RIMP is a 10-year forgivable loan for active farmsteads and rural businesses being displaced by the project, including the Southern Embankment and Associated Infrastructure (SEAI), SWDCAI and the Upstream Mitigation Area (UMA). The RIMP is a voluntary program being implemented by the Cass County Joint Water Resource District (CCJWRD) in North Dakota and the Moorhead Clay Count Joint Powers Agreement (MCCJPA) in Minnesota but is funded by the Metro Flood Diversion Authority (MFDA).

#### **BOARD HISTORY**

The RIMP process was brought to the Land Management Committee, the Finance Committee, and the Metro Flood Diversion Authority Board in May of 2020.

- A. Land Management Committee May 27, 2020:
  - An overview of the Farmstead Reestablishment Program also called the RIMP was presented to the Committee and received positive feedback from Committee members.
  - b. The Committee approved it unanimously.
- B. Finance Committee May 27, 2020:
  - An overview of the Farmstead Reestablishment Program also called the RIMP was presented to the Committee and received mixed feedback from Committee members.
  - b. The RIMP was estimated to be \$5-10 million in cost and there were two properties identified over the next 6 months.
  - c. Committee Chair was not comfortable with this cost range and suggested a phased approach
  - d. Committee approved to move forward on a phased approach for the two parcels identified with a cap of \$5 million.
- C. Metro Flood Diversion Authority Board May 28, 2020:

- a. An overview of the Farmstead Reestablishment Program also called the RIMP was presented to the Board and received mixed feedback from Board members.
- b. The Board approved to move forward on a phased approach for the two parcels identified with a cap of \$5 million.

#### PRAM

The RIMP was then included in Version 5 of the Property Rights Acquisition and Mitigation Plan that was approved by the state of North Dakota.

#### **SETTLEMENT**

Section 25 of the Settlement Agreement between the Metro Flood Diversion Authority and the Richland-Wilkin Joint Powers Authority, Buffalo-Red Watershed District, City of Wolverton, and City of Comstock includes the requirement for the RIMP.

#### TO DATE

The CCJWRD has approved three RIMP loans at the two locations totaling approximately \$4.2 million in value for businesses along the SWDCAI.

#### **FUTURE USE OF THIS PROGRAM**

As the land agents are starting to engage with property owners in the UMA and during the recent financial re-baselining of the entire Program, the Director of Lands and the Land Program Management team reviewed the RIMP and identified a total of approximately 15 farmsteads and rural businesses, including the three that have been approved, that are eligible for RIMP with a total cost of approximately \$15 million. Additionally, this team currently refining the process and developing a reporting mechanism for the CCJWRD, MCCJPA and the Board Finance Committee.

#### **BUDGFT**

Funding for the RIMP was anticipated in the 2022 Lands budget and was approved in the 2022 Cash Budget pending this phased approval. So, *no impact* to the 2022 Cash Budget is anticipated. The total cost of \$15 million is included in the re-baselined Program Budget and has been included in the latest version of the Financial Plan.

#### **ACTION**

Since the RIMP was approved at the Finance Committee and Board in a phased approach in 2020, the Finance Committee and Board would need to approve additional funding for this next phase of the RIMP.

#### PROPOSED MOTION

In order to meet the obligations of the MFDA by continuing the RIMP, and to make a concerted effort to protect farmsteads and rural businesses directly impacted by the Comprehensive Project, I move to approve the next phase of the RIMP and allocate an additional \$10 million to the RIMP.

#### **OVERVIEW**

Local Flood Protection and Associated Infrastructure, formerly referenced as the In-Kind Work Plan or In-Town Projects, has been developed and approved by the Diversion Authority Board and the Member Entities. The LFPAI summarizes the additional impacts and measures that need to be implemented to accommodate a flow through the Fargo-Moorhead urban area that produces a river stage of 37 feet during a 100-year flood event. Member entities include the - City of Fargo, City of Moorhead, Cass County, Cass County Joint Water Resource District and Clay County. LFPAI project development through construction is led by the member entity jurisdiction where the construction is occurring.

#### **BOARD HISTORY**

The Metro Flood Diversion Authority(MFDA) approved the "2022 Cash Budget" at their December 16, 2021, meeting. The 2022 Cash Budget included all costs associated with the City of Fargo 2022 Work Plan for a total approved budget of \$25,000,000 for the City of Fargo Work Plan.

The MFDA then approved the "Resolution Approving the Procedure for Requesting that the City of Fargo Undertake Development of Comprehensive Project In-Kind Work Elements and Authorizing the Reimbursement of Such Development Costs and Expenses" at their January 27, 2022, meeting. The approved resolution includes the following sections:

#### Section 2. Intent.

Consistent with section 12.09 of the JPA, the Authority intends that its Member Entities will develop an Estimated Total Project Cost and present such cost to the Authority's Executive Director for review. Once the Authority accepts the Estimated Total Project Costs and notifies the Member Entity to proceed with the In-Kind Work, the Member Entity would not require additional budget approvals from the Authority unless the cost of the In-Kind Work exceeds the Estimated Total Project Cost.

#### Section 3. In-Kind Work Plan.

A. The FM Diversion Plan B – River Stage 37' Impacts technical memorandum, dated July 13, 2018 (the "In-Kind Work Plan"), has been developed and approved by the Diversion Authority Board and the Member Entities. The In-Kind Work Plan summarizes the additional impacts and measures that need to be implemented to accommodate a flow through the Fargo-Moorhead urban area that produces a river stage of 37 feet during a 100-year flood event. The In-Kind Work Plan additionally assigns In-Kind Work Elements to Member Entities and includes estimated construction costs. When the Applicable Member Entity completes an In-Kind Work

- Element, it will retain ownership of all work completed in accordance with the In-Kind Work Plan. Any change in scope of an approved In-Kind Work Element shall be approved by the Diversion Authority Board.
- B. On an annual basis, prior to the Applicable Member Entity seeking official approval from its governing body of the Applicable Member Entity's annual Capital Improvement Plan, the Applicable Member Entity and the Authority's Director of Engineering or his/her designee will mutually review and update the In-Kind Work Plan for In-Kind Work Elements to be developed and/or maintained, including routine maintenance and capital maintenance improvements in accordance with the JPA and other agreed upon resolutions between the Member Entity and the Authority, in the new Fiscal Year. Updates for each In-Kind Work Element will be based on a current Development Plan Summary Sheet, described in Section 4 below.
- C. Following the updates described in the preceding Section, if the budget for the cost of an In-Kind Work Element exceeds the initial Estimated Total Project Cost, the Applicable Member Entity and the Authority's Director of Engineering or his/her designee will present the updates to the In-Kind Work Element to the Finance Committee and Diversion Authority Board for review and approval. Following approval of the updates to each In-Kind Work Element, the Authority will incorporate the updated Estimated Total Project Cost for the In-Kind Work Elements into the annual Authority budget for the new Fiscal Year until all In-Kind Work Elements have been constructed. Operation and maintenance costs of In-Kind Work Elements will be provided in the Authority's annual budget that are agreed upon in existing and future operations and maintenance agreements, resolutions or plans between the Member Entity and the Authority.
- D. If the budget for the cost of an In-Kind Work Element does not exceed the initial Estimated Total Project Cost, the Authority will incorporate the Estimated Total Project Cost for the In-Kind Work Element into the annual Authority budget for the new Fiscal Year for approval by the Diversion Authority Board. The Executive Director will present the updated In-Kind Work Plan for these In-Kind Work Elements to the Diversion Authority Board in conjunction with the annual Authority budget until all In-Kind Work Elements have been constructed.

#### **CITY OF FARGO 2022 WORK PLAN**

Given that the "Resolution Approving the Procedure for Requesting that the City of Fargo Undertake Development of Comprehensive Project In-Kind Work Elements and Authorizing the Reimbursement of Such Development Costs and Expenses" was approved after approval of the "Cash Budget", the Development Plan Summary Sheets for the City of Fargo's 2022 projects were not submitted for consideration of approval by the MFDA Board of Authority ahead of approval of 2022 Cash Budget.

Nathan Boerboom, City of Fargo, has provided a letter summarizing cost and scope changes for the three projects that are planned to begin construction in 2022. The letter includes the Development Plan Summary Sheet for each of the three projects (letter and summary sheets attached). It should be noted that after reviewing each project, costs have increased for some of the projects primarily due to inflation as the conceptual level estimates were developed in 2018. Some of the cost estimates have been reduced due to scope reductions or value engineering. The scope of work was not increased for any of the three projects. The attached letter provided by the City of Fargo goes into greater detail for each of the three projects, however the changes in cost for each of the three projects is summarized below:

**FM-19-C (Phases 1 and 2):** 2018 Estimate = \$13,055,000; 2022 Engineer's Estimate = \$10,037,060 **Estimated Cost Reduction = (\$3,017,940)** 

**FM-22-C1:** 2018 Estimate = \$5,782,000; 2022 Engineer's Estimate = \$9,242,000 **Estimated Cost Increase = \$3,460,000** 

**FM-22-B1:** 2018 Estimate = \$3,146,000; 2022 Engineer's Estimate = \$1,727,000 **Estimated Cost Reduction = (\$1,419,000)** 

Total 2022 Estimated Cost Reduction of the Three Projects = (\$976,940)

#### **FINANCING**

Consistent with the Financial Plan for the Comprehensive Project, the MFDA submitted applications for State Revolving Fund (SRF) Clean Water Loans for all three construction projects to be completed by the City of Fargo in 2022. The MFDA Clean Water SRF loan was approved by the ND Industrial Commission on March 24, 2022. It is anticipated that the Diversion Authority Board will be asked to approve the SRF loan documents at its regular May meeting, assuming bids are awarded for the City of Fargo projects contemplated herein.

#### **ACTION**

Per the "Resolution Approving the Procedure for Requesting that the City of Fargo Undertake Development of Comprehensive Project In-Kind Work Elements and Authorizing the Reimbursement of Such Development Costs and Expenses" the MFDA Board of Authority should consider approval of the Development Plan Summary Sheets for the three City of Fargo projects to begin construction in 2022 including approval of their "Estimated Total Project Cost" that has been updated since the 2018 conceptual level cost estimates.

#### **PROPOSED MOTION**

Per the "Resolution Approving the Procedure for Requesting that the City of Fargo Undertake Development of Comprehensive Project In-Kind Work Elements and Authorizing the Reimbursement of Such Development Costs and Expenses" I move to approve the Development Plan Summary Sheets and the Estimated Total Project Costs for the three City of Fargo project to begin construction in 2022. The three projects include Project No. FM-19-C – Woodcrest Flood Risk Management, Project No. FM-22-C1 – Storm Sewer Lift Stations #55 & #56 Reconstruction, and Project No. FM-22-B1 – Storm Sewer Lift Station #15 Modifications.

Dear Mr. Bakkegard:

As you are aware, the City has three in-town flood risk management projects scheduled to be constructed this upcoming construction season. Two of these projects are out for bid and the third's design is nearing completion. As part of the recent progress on the projects, we have also completed updated Engineer's Estimates for the construction costs. Therefore, per the Diversion Authority's resolution outlining the requirements Fargo shall follow for these projects, we are submitting updated Development Plan Summary Sheets (attached) for each project.

The following are updates for each of the three projects:

#### Project No. FM-19-C - Woodcrest Flood Risk Management

The 2018 conceptual level estimate for this project was \$5,900,000. During project development, the City made the decision to include the reconstruction of storm sewer lift station #39 (originally identified in 2018 to be a standalone project) with this project. The 2018 conceptual level estimate for these two combined projects was \$13,055,000. Currently, this project is scheduled to be completed under two separate phases. The first phase, Project No. FM-19-C1, is scheduled to begin this summer and carryover into 2023. The current project cost estimate is \$7,012,060. The second phase, Project No. FM-19-C3, is preliminarily scheduled to occur in 2024 and its project cost is estimated to be \$3,025,000. The combined estimate for these two phases is \$10,037,060, which includes a 10% contingency, and is more than \$3,000,000 less than the 2018 estimates. This reduction in budget is a result of numerous factors, but can primarily be attributed to the relocation of storm sewer lift station #39 into the project limits instead of its current location on the VA Hospital's property and the final design that allows the levee to be constructed without having to fully acquire three residential properties.

#### Project No. FM-22-C1 - Storm Sewer Lift Stations #55 & #56 Reconstruction

The 2018 conceptual level estimate for this project was \$5,782,000. The scope of this project has been unchanged since the conceptual level estimate but a combination of factors have influenced the current project estimate, which is estimated to be \$9,242,000 and includes a 10% contingency. There are primarily two factors that heavily influenced the change in the estimate. First would be the constructability of these two lift stations, which after conversations with contractors it was determined will likely influence the cost of construction. Second is the inflation that has occurred since the original estimate was developed in 2018 and more specifically in the past few months. To reduce the financial impacts of this project, the City did incorporate various value-engineering items in the design that reduced the total number of structures required as well as the overall depth of the remaining structures. Please note that this project was originally numbered Project No. FM-14-71, but is now being referred to as Project No. FM-22-C1.

#### Project No. FM-22-B1 - Storm Sewer Lift Station #15 Modifications

The 2018 conceptual level estimate for this project was \$3,146,000. The scope of this project has been reduced since the City has determined that the existing storm sewer lift station structure is in good condition and is able to be modified to meet the current pumping capacity needs for this area. This reduces the overall project estimate since the structure does not need to be reconstructed. The City has also determined that it is able to self-perform the primary design services of this project and only needs outside engineering assistance on the design components that the City does not have expertise on. Due to these scope changes, the current project estimate is \$1,727,000.00, which includes inflation costs since the 2018 estimate as well as a 10% contingency.

The City would appreciate a timely review of the attached Project Development Summary Sheets since we currently have two projects, No. FM-19-C1 and No. FM-22-C1, scheduled to accept construction bids on May 25<sup>th</sup> and May 11<sup>th</sup> respectively. Please note that we intend to award the projects to the low bidder, if bids received are acceptable, at the May 16<sup>th</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup> Fargo City Commission meetings. This quick turnaround of awarding of the contracts is necessary due to the current bidding market and how long material suppliers' quotes are available to the Contractors.

Please let me know if you have any questions regarding these projects and thank you in advance for your timely response to this request.

"Comprehensive Project"<sup>2</sup> – this is a preferred definition in legal documents for the entire project.

"Comprehensive Project" means construction of a storm water diversion channel through North Dakota that conveys twenty thousand (20,000) cubic feet per second at the one percent (1%) chance of a one hundred (100)-year event and is approximately thirty (30) miles long with tie-back embankments, a staging area, a Diversion Inlet Structure, a six (6)-mile connecting channel, a control structure on each of the Red and Wild Rice Rivers, an aqueduct hydraulic structure on each of the Maple and Sheyenne Rivers, a drop structure of each of the Rush and Lower Rush Rivers, four (4) railroad bridges, In-Town Work, community ring levees, and environmental mitigation, as generally described in the Final Feasibility Report and Environmental Impact Statement, Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project, dated July 2011, and approved by the Chief of Engineers on December 19, 2011, as amended by the Supplemental Environment Assessment, Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project, dated September 2013, and approved by District Engineer, St. Paul District, on September 19, 2013, and the Final Supplemental Environmental Assessment #2, Fargo Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project, dated February 2019, and approved by the District Engineer, St. Paul District, on February 28, 2019. (from the MIT).

"Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project" – this is a preferred definition in legal documents for the entire project, often defined in legal documents as, Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project (the "Comprehensive Project").

"Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project" has the same definition as the Comprehensive Project in the Master Indenture of Trust and is the name given to the Comprehensive Project by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

"FM Area Diversion" – not commonly used in legal documents by the Authority.

"FM Diversion" – should not be used when referencing the Comprehensive Project.

"Project" – this is usually used to define a smaller project within the Comprehensive Project, in an agreement, i.e. a utility relocation project; in the Project Agreement and MIT, Project is also synonymous with the terms DCAI and SWDCAI.

"Project" means the construction of the SWDCAI pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Project Agreement. (From the MIT).

#### 2. Terms Used for Components and Features of the Comprehensive Project

"SWDCAI" means the Storm Water Diversion Channel and Associated Infrastructure located on the north of the Red River of the North (the "Red River"), which conveys flows of twenty thousand (20,000) cubic feet per second during a one-hundred (100)-year flood event. The diversion channel consists of six (6) channel segments up to three hundred (300) feet wide, approximately thirty (30) feet deep, thirty (30) miles in length, with four (4) railroad bridges, four (4) two-lane interstate bridges, and up to eleven (11) county highway bridges crossing the diversion channel and two (2) aqueduct hydraulic structures to convey the normal flow of the Sheyenne and Maple Rivers over the diversion channel to preserve fish crossings, in addition to ten (10) local stormwater drain inlets.

"DCAI" means the Diversion Channel and Associated Infrastructure. Although this term has been historically used when referencing the SWDCAI, it should not be used when referencing the SWDCAI.

"SEAI" means the Southern Embankment and Associated Infrastructure and consists of three (3) control structures: the Diversion Inlet Structure, Wild Rice River Control Structure, and Red River Structure, as well as associated road raises, an earthen embankment, and western tie-back levee. Features of the SEAI include the following:

- <u>Diversion Inlet Structure (DIS)</u>: The DIS is the hydraulic control structure that controls the flow of water entering the SWDCAI north of the SEAI as detailed in the document entitled the "FMM Diversion Inlet Control Structure Red River of the North River Basin Fargo, ND." The DIS consists of three (3), fifty (50) foot wide tainter gates.
- Red River Structure (RRS): The RRS is the hydraulic control structure to be procured by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers designed to control and/or meter the flow of the Red River through the Protected Area. The RRS consists of three (3), fifty (50) foot wide tainter gates.
- Wild Rice River Structure (WRRS): The WRRS is the control structure for the Wild Rice River located southeast of the City of Horace, North Dakota. The WRRS consists of two (2), forty (40) foot wide tainter gates.

"LFPAI" means Local Flood Protection and Associated Infrastructure, which has been developed and approved by the Diversion Authority Board and the Member Entities. The In-Kind Work Plan summarizes the additional impacts and measures that need to be implemented to accommodate a flow through the Fargo-Moorhead urban area that produces a river stage of 37 feet during a 100-year flood event. Member entities include the - City of Fargo, City of Moorhead, Cass County and Clay County.

"MFAI" means Mitigation Features and Associated Infrastructure – MFAI includes any project that is required to be completed as mitigation for the Comprehensive Project. This may include but is not limited to physical, social, and environmental impacts. Certain MFAI projects may be located within the UMA. A MFAI project may be a result of the Comprehensive Project's environmental documentation, the Property Rights Acquisition and Mitigation Plan, a permit condition, the Settlement Agreement, or other binding agreement between the Authority and another party. MFAI include but are not limited to:

- Drain 27 Wetland Mitigation
- OHB Levee
- Drayton Dam
- Property/Structure Removal Work Packages
- Flowage Easements in the UMA

- Lower Otter Tail River Restoration Project
- Cemetery Mitigation
- City of Christine
- City of Comstock
- City of Georgetown
- City of Wolverton

"Upstream Mitigation Area" or "UMA" means the area where the Authority is required to obtain property rights for the temporary storage of floodwaters during Comprehensive Project Operation.

#### 3. Terms Used to Define the Metro Flood Diversion Authority

"Authority" 4 – this is the preferred abbreviation to be used in legal documents.

The METRO FLOOD DIVERSION AUTHORITY (the "Authority"), a permanent North Dakota political subdivision and joint powers entity formed through the Joint Powers Agreement, dated June 1, 2016, by and among the City of Moorhead, the City of Fargo, Clay County, Cass County and the Cass County Joint Water Resource District. (From the Project Agreement).

"Metro Flood Diversion Authority"<sup>5</sup> – this is the official name of the joint powers entity, often defined in legal documents as Metro Flood Diversion Authority (the "Authority").

"Metro Flood Diversion Authority" has the same definition as "Authority."

"MFDA" – not commonly used in legal documents by the Authority but commonly used as an acronym for the Metro Flood Diversion Authority.

"Flood Diversion Authority" – should not be used when referencing the Metro Flood Diversion Authority.
