Metro Flood Diversion Authority Finance Committee Meeting Minutes

4:00 P.M. – April 26, 2023 City of Fargo Commission Chambers

A regular meeting of the Metro Flood Diversion Authority Finance Committee was held on April 26, 2023. The following members were present: Bernie Dardis, Mayor, City of West Fargo; Dr. Tim Mahoney, Mayor, City of Fargo; Chad Peterson, Cass County Commissioner; Lori Johnson, Clay County Auditor/Treasurer; Mike Redlinger, Administrator, City of Fargo; Dave Piepkorn, Fargo City Commissioner; Shelly Carlson, Mayor, City of Moorhead; Rick Steen, Cass County Joint Water Resource District and Brandy Madrigga, Cass County Finance Director.

Member(s) absent: Terri Gayhart, City of Fargo Finance Director and Mike Rietz, City of Moorhead Assistant City Manager.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Dardis called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. Roll call was taken, and a quorum was present.

2. APPROVE MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 2023 MEETING

MOTION PASSED

Mayor Mahoney moved to approve the minutes from the March 2023, meeting and Mr. Peterson seconded the motion. On a voice vote, the motion carried.

3. APPROVE ORDER OF AGENDA

MOTION PASSED

Mayor Mahoney moved to approve the order of the agenda and Mr. Steen seconded the motion. On a voice vote, the motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS

Mr. Papenfuss reported that the bills payable as of April 19, 2023, total \$6,871,312 and are payable to the usual vendors, CCJWRD, Ohnstad Twichell, Clay County, City of Fargo, City of Christine and Cass County. AON Risk Services was the largest payable at \$5,448,765 for general and excess liability coverage.

MOTION PASSED

Mayor Mahoney moved to approve the bills as presented and Mr. Steen seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Papenfuss reported that we have \$166,223,715 in assets, \$360,056 in liabilities and the current net position is \$165,863,660.

6. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Paulsen reported that the sales tax revenue is being received as expected and was the only revenue received this month. The overall budget is \$2.8 billion and \$923.8 million is the actual cost to date. The operations budget continues to track on target and there are no issues or concerns.

2023 CASH BUDGET CHANGE REQUEST

Mr. Paulsen requested an increase of \$60,000 to cover the 2021/2022 O&M reimbursement costs due to the City of Fargo.

MOTION PASSED

Mr. Steen moved to approve the cash budget change request and Mr. Piepkorn seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried.

8. CONTRACTING ACTIONS

a. DA Board Approval Contracting Action

Mr. Paulsen provided an overview of the following contracting action:

 AECOM Master Services Agreement – Consulting Services – Renew Master Services Agreement to perform cultural resource investigations. Extend period of performance to April 30, 2026 - \$0.00.

MOTION PASSED

Mayor Mahoney moved to approve the contracting action as presented and Mr. Peterson seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried.

MOUs and AGREEMENTS

Mr. Shockley provided an overview and summary of the following funding agreement and MOU:

 BRRWD Lower Otter Tail River Restoration Project & MFDA Funding Agreement MDNR Permit Condition No. 27

This agreement applies to the MDNR's Dam Safety & Public Waters Work Permit (Permit Number 2018-0819) authorizing construction of the Comprehensive FM Area Diversion Project. Specifically, Permit Condition 27 pertains to environmental mitigation that must be completed by the MFDA and in part discusses the responsibilities to provide partial funding of the Lower Otter Tail River Restoration Project (LOTRRP). The Authority is required under this agreement to remit \$8.28 Million to the BRRWD for the LOTRRP. This cost was included both within the program budget and approved as part of the 2023 Cash Budget.

 Raymond Township & MFDA MOU SWDCAI

The MOU addresses design, construction, operating and maintenance, future changes or additions, etc. in respect to any impacts that the Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Area Flood Risk Management Project will have on township roadways. Design, construction, and maintenance costs will be covered by the Developer through the Project Agreement. Reimbursement includes the following: Construction costs and expenses up to \$3,000 annually from the effective date until project substantial completion; post-construction costs and expenses up to \$1,500 annually after project substantial completion; a lost tax revenue payment of \$4,360 (this will be divided into ten equal payments and paid out annually over ten years); and a \$30,000 payment for fire protection funds.

MOTION PASSED

Mayor Mahoney moved to approve the funding agreement and MOU together and Ms. Madrigga seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried.

10. OTHER BUSINESS

There was no other business to report.

11. NEXT MEETING

The next meeting will be May 24, 2023.

12. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 4:21 PM.

BCR-012 SWDCAI Utility Relocations

BCR-012 is a 2023 Cash Budget change request to add in \$2,565,128 to the cash budget for the Magellan Pipeline in the SWDCAI. This cash budget adjustment is needed because the final billing was included in the 2022 Cash Budget, but the invoice from Magellan for the pipeline relocation across the channel ROW was not received until January 2023. The remaining work to install electronic controls for the remotely operated valve is to be completed in the next few weeks. This is estimated to be approximately \$250,000 and is included in the Cash Budget carry-over amount. The overall utility relocation estimated cost is approximately \$900,000 under the approved total budget.

BCR-013 SEAI & UMA Utility Relocations

BCR-013 is a 2023 Cash Budget change request to add in \$566,911 to the cash budget for various utility relocations in the SEAI and UMA. This cash budget adjustment is primarily needed due to project work completed in 2022 but the final billings and as-builts are being received in 2023. The Sprint fiber relocation accounts for the majority of this BCR as we are anticipating a final billing for this work, which was approved for \$540,321.36.

BCR-014 SEAI & UMA Authority Led Utility Relocations

BCR-014 is a 2023 Cash Budget change request to add in \$1,600,000 for a new work package (WP-47) for Authority led utility relocations in the SEAI and UMA. This cash budget adjustment for 2023 accounts for the following utility relocation work:

- WP-47A Utility relocations for SE-2, SE-2B, OHB, SE-4 and SE-5 The current engineer's estimate for this work is \$1,160,000 of which \$1,000,000 is anticipated to be spent in 2023. The project will be bid in the summer of 2023.
- WP-47C This project includes the test borings and test wells for permanent production wells to be completed for the Cass Rural Water Users District wells at Reservoir Site A. The current engineer's estimate for this work is \$600,000 to be bid and spent in 2023.

Proposed Scope and Fee for FM Area Diversion Recreation Plan Feasibility Study

May 17, 2023

OVERVIEW

The Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) completed the Fargo-Moorhead Greenway Master Plan (the Plan) in 2020. The Plan identified a range of recreation projects that could be considered for incorporation as part of the FMAD Project. Elements identified within the Plan have not currently been incorporated into the FM Area Diversion project, primarily due to the inability to identify a governing body that would be responsible for the planning and design; construction; and operations and maintenance of the recreation facilities.

MFDA COMMITTEE & BOARD HISTORY

The Metro Flood Diversion Authority (MFDA) has discussed incorporation of recreational facilities into the FMAD Project at several Committee and Board meetings. Many discussions have surrounded grant opportunities available within the state of North Dakota for recreational facilities.

At the February 22, 2023, Finance Committee meeting, a request was made to add \$30,000 into the 2023 Cash Budget for recreational grant research. It was decided to table the item until additional clarification and information could be brought forward to the full Board for discussion. The Board wanted further information regarding the scope of work that would be included for this work and discussed developing a Recreation Task Force to guide this process.

At the March 7, 2023, Planning Committee meeting, the committee discussed the development of a Recreation Task Force. Mr. Paulsen shared that the intent of the recreational task force is to define a direction and scope for the recreational plan. It is in concept phase and will expand as the plan develops. It was noted that RRVA will be included in the discussions as the recreational plan could potentially change the operations and maintenance costs to be charged by RRVA and could also result in additional capital costs. Mr. Paulsen is working to compile a list of potential task force members representing the cities of Fargo, West Fargo, Horace, and Moorhead as well as Cass County.

At the April 11, 2023, Planning Committee meeting, the committee discussed that we need to determine what we can do with recreation facilities with both the P3 agreement and other components of the overall project along with what the potential costs may be and the best way to proceed forward. The Planning Committee passed a motion to retain an independent consultant to work with staff to develop a list of acceptable items per the P3 agreement, not to exceed \$10,000 in consulting fees.

RECREATION PLAN FEASIBILITY STUDY SCOPE AND FEE

Per the motion from the April 11, 2023, Planning Committee meeting, the requested budget is \$10,000 to complete a high-level feasibility study for incorporating recreational facilities into the overall FM Area Diversion project. This will allow for approximately forty hours to complete the following proposed scope of work:

- Review the existing Fargo Moorhead Greenway Master Plan (the Plan) dated November 2020.
- Compare the Plan with what is currently included in the P3 Project Agreement.
- Coordinate with legal counsel to determine what is legally allowed to be placed on different Project elements.
- Evaluate if any additional features in the Plan can be added to the P3
- Review the USACE and FEMA restrictions on the SEAI, OHB Ring Levee, Upstream Mitigation Area (UMA) and In-Town projects
- Evaluate if any features of the Plan can be incorporated into the SEAI, OHB, UMA and In-town features
- Identify next steps for the future Recreation Task Force.

PROPOSED MOTION

I move to approve the addition of \$10,000 into the 2023 Cash Budget for the MFDA to retain the services of a consultant to complete the Recreation Plan Feasibility Study scope of work as identified within this memorandum.

City of Fargo Work Plan for Projects Bid in 2023 Executive Summary

May 17, 2023

The following executive summary provides an overview of the status of City of Fargo revised work plan for Local Flood Protection and Associated Infrastructure (LFPAI) component of the FM Area Diversion as of May 2023.

OVERVIEW

LFPAI, formerly referenced as the In-Kind Work Plan or In-Town Projects, has been developed and approved by the Diversion Authority Board and the Member Entities. The LFPAI summarizes the additional impacts and measures that need to be implemented to accommodate a flow through the Fargo-Moorhead urban area that produces a river stage of 37 feet during a 100-year flood event. Member entities include the - City of Fargo, City of Moorhead, Cass County, Cass County Joint Water Resource District and Clay County. LFPAI project development through construction is led by the member entity jurisdiction where the construction is occurring.

BOARD HISTORY

The Metro Flood Diversion Authority(MFDA) approved the "2023 Cash Budget" at their December 15, 2022, meeting. The 2023 Cash Budget included all costs associated with the City of Fargo 2023 Work Plan for a total approved budget of \$22,000,000.

The MFDA approved the "Resolution Approving the Procedure for Requesting that the City of Fargo Undertake Development of Comprehensive Project In-Kind Work Elements and Authorizing the Reimbursement of Such Development Costs and Expenses" at their January 27, 2022, meeting.

CITY OF FARGO 2023 PROJECTS BID WORK PLAN – January 2023

The City of Fargo bid the following project in 2023 as follows:

NR-23-A1 (Now will be NR-23-A2 & NR-23-A3): STS LS #47 & #48 Reconstruction

- This project scope includes reconstruction of storm sewer lift stations #47 and 48, I-29 ditch modifications adjacent to Drain 27, and two Drain 27 culvert replacements.
- In December 2022, the MFDA Board of Authority approved the 2023 cash budget which included \$4,900,000 for construction on this project in 2023. The overall project budget of \$6,200,000 was based on the 2018 project estimate and the scope of the overall project has not changed. It was estimated that only \$4,900,000 for the project would be spent in 2023.
- In January 2023, the MFDA Board of Authority approved a total project budget increase of \$4,808,250. This increased the previously approved total project budget from \$6,200,000 to \$11,008,250. The \$11,008,250 new project budget was based on the updated engineer's estimate and again the scope of the overall project has not changed. In January 2023, the 2023

cash budget was not amended, as the estimated spend of \$4,900,000 in 2023 did not change. The increase in the overall project budget was based on the following items:

- The increase in the engineer's estimate from the 2018 cost estimate is due to the current bidding market and inflation impacts.
- This project is projected to be bid in Q1 2023 and will be constructed in both 2023 and 2024.
- At the time of the approved total project budget increase, the design of the project was
 95% complete and property acquisition was 50% complete.
- The City of Fargo received bids for the project in April 2023, with the low bid coming in higher than the engineer's estimate. The new total project budget is \$11,664,829.90, which is approximately 6% higher than the previously approved project budget. The increase in the overall project budget is based on the following items:
 - The overall construction bid came in approximately 8% higher than the previously approved project budget which was based on the 95% design engineer's estimate.
 - The City of Fargo reduced the contingency down to 5%.
 - Construction services cost estimates were increased to reflect the additional inspection time required for the project.
 - The anticipated spend in 2023 did not change at \$4,900,000 and therefore a 2023 cash budget amendment is not required.

NR-23-A1: 2023 Total Project Budget including construction bid, construction services and contingencies = \$11,664,829.90 of which \$4,900,000 is projected to be spent in 2023.

Requested Total Project Budget Increase = \$656,579.90

If the proposed motion below is approved, City of Fargo project NR-23-A1 will have a total project budget increase of \$656,579.90. It is important to note that the anticipated project spend in 2023 has been approved as part of the 2023 Cash Budget and therefore an amendment to the cash budget is not needed.

Additional Notes:

This project was identified as being necessary during the overall project's Plan B development and is anticipated to be constructed during the 2023 and 2024 construction seasons. During scoping of the project, the City determined it would be most cost effective to have this project also include the Interstate 29 ditch modifications adjacent to Drain 27, as well as two Drain 27 culvert replacements, which were both identified under Plan B's in-town additional projects. The original scope for all three of these previously identified projects are unchanged from 2018.

The 2018 estimated total project cost was approximately \$6,200,000. The current project estimate is now estimated to be \$11,008,250 (including contingencies) primarily as a result of it costs since 2018 due to inflation. The average inflation rates the City has seen since 2018 is 8% in 2019, 8% in 2020, 10% in 2021 and 20% in 2022.

Bids were received on 4/26/2023 and the low bid was 8% higher than the engineer's estimate. Since low bid is within the approved contingency amount, the City of Fargo is recommending award of the project to Key Contracting (general contract - Project #NR-23-A2) and Fusion Automation (electrical contract - Project #NR-23-A3). The combined bids for these two contracts are \$9,963,816.81. In addition to the bids coming in higher, the City also increased the construction services budget for Houston Engineering to reflect the additional inspection time required for the project. The original scope of work for Houston was based on a 24 week construction duration. However, due to contractor availability as well as to make the project more attractive to potential bidders, the City bid the project to span the construction over two years. This change is anticipated to result in Houston being required to complete construction services for 56 weeks, which their budget shown within this document has been updated to reflect this additional time.
