INVITATION TO SUBMIT STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION FOR

Respondents shall electronically deliver their Statement of Qualifications by Thursday, November 21, 2024, at 1:00pm Central Time to the Authority's PMC Program Manager Paul Barthel at paul.barthel@jacobs.com as described in the RFQ. Selection will be based upon (1) successful delivery on past projects of similar scope and complexity, (2) experience and qualifications of proposed project team members, including subcontractors, and (3) demonstrated knowledge of the services to be performed.

Attendance at the pre-proposal conference is not mandatory. Proposers will be notified electronically if selected to negotiate a MACS with the Authority.

All Proposers should be advised that if awarded, the Construction Contractor shall comply with the (i) American Iron and Steel requirements; (ii) Civil Rights requirements; (iii) Equal Employment Opportunity requirements; (iv) create an affirmative action plan; (v) provide evidenced of compliance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) participation; (vi) and provide evidence of compliance with the Davis Bacon Act as more fully set forth in the draft MACS.
