Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Utility Relocations – Cass Rural Water Ring Levee and Wells – Phase 47F (WP-47F)** project will be received at the office of Ohnstad Twichell, 444 Sheyenne Street, Suite 102, West Fargo, ND 58078, until 1:00 pm local time on April 9, 2026. The project includes civil site work including construction of a ring levee around Cass Rural Water District Reservoir A and associated well field, pond expansion and lift station construction and discharge, utility work consisting of installation of two new 8-inch raw water transmission lines, completion of five new production wells on existing well casings, installation of water distribution lines, removal and abandonment of existing wells and underground utilities.

The project also includes installation of underground electrical conduit and conductors, site control panels for 5 wells and one storm sewer lift station, exterior distribution cabinet, and interior improvements including new disconnect panel, step transformer, distribution and controls wiring.

Separate bids will be received for Contract A – General and Contract B – Electrical.

This Project will be 100 percent funded by a combination of North Dakota State Water Commission funds, City of Fargo sales tax revenues, and Cass County sales tax revenues.

Following Aconex registration, Prospective Bidder shall e-mail the Program Management Consultant (PMC) via FMDiversion@ch2m.com to request access to the bid package. Allow up to 48 hours for access to be granted. After access is granted, a complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the Issuing Office in portable document format (PDF) files. Printed sets of the Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Bidding Documents may also be examined at Jacobs, 4784 Amber Valley Parkway South, Suite 200, Fargo, ND 58104, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., by appointment. Please contact Diane Spaeth at Diane.Spaeth@jacobs.com to set up an appointment.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 a.m. local time on March 26, 2026, via live video conference. Please contact Ian Joynes at ian.joynes@jacobs.com for an invitation to this virtual meeting. Site visits may be scheduled upon request. Submit requests for site visits to Aconex as RFIs. Arrange personal transportation for the site visit.

Attendance at the pre-bid conference and site visits are not mandatory.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a Bidder's bond in a sum equal to five percent (5%) of the full amount of the Bid, executed by the Bidder as principal and by a surety company authorized to do business in this state, conditioned that if the principal's Bid be accepted and the contract awarded to them, within ten (10) days after notice of award Bidder will execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of the Bid and a contractor's bond as required by law and the regulations and determinations of the governing board. Each bid shall include an acknowledgement of receipt of Addenda. Such acknowledgement shall be on the form provided in the Instructions to Bidders and shall be included in the separate envelope with the Bid Bond and North Dakota Contractor's License or acknowledge receipt of Addenda on the outside of the Bid envelope.

All Bidders should be advised that if awarded, the Contractor shall comply with the (i) American Iron and Steel requirements; (ii) Civil Rights requirements; (iii) Equal Employment Opportunity requirements; (iv) create an affirmative action plan; (v) provide evidenced of compliance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) participation; (vi) and provide evidence of compliance with the Davis Bacon Act as more fully set forth in the draft Contract. Each bid shall be accompanied, in the same envelope, by bidder's completed (i) MBE/WBE Subcontractor Solicitation Information form; (ii) Certification regarding Debarment, Suspension, and other Responsibilities form; (iii) DBE Subcontractor Utilization form, and (iv) DBE Subcontractor Performance form.

In compliance with Section 43-07-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, each contractor submitting a bid must have a copy of Bidder's North Dakota Contractor's License or certificate of renewal thereof, issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State, and Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry enclosed in the separate bid bond envelope; must be licensed for the highest amount of Bidder's total bid combination; and such license must have been in effect at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the bid opening.

No bid will be read or considered which does not fully comply with the provisions herein as to bonds and licenses, MBE/WBE form, Disbarment form, DBE forms, and acknowledgment of Addenda. Any deficient bid submitted will be resealed and returned to bidder immediately.

Bid security shall be made payable to the Owner. Bid securities of the two lowest Bidders will be retained until Contract has been awarded and executed, but not longer than 30 days.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive informalities therein.
